# MSME Amnesty Guide Booklet

## About the MSME Amnesty Programme

The *Micro*, *Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) Amnesty Programme*, offers an opportunity for MSMEs conducting business in Belize, to formalise their status with the Belize Tax Service (BTS).

Upon successful registration, MSMEs will qualify for business tax exemption for a period of one year from the date of issue of the Amnesty Certificate and will not be liable any accrued penalties or interest related to business tax obligations.

### Benefits:

- One Year Exemption from the payment of business tax from the date of issue of the Amnesty Certificate
- Waiver of accrued business tax interest
- Waiver of accrued tax penalty
- Eligibility to participate in Government of Belize tenders
- Eligible for Fiscal Incentives
- Improved public and private collaboration
- Eligibility to participate in other MSME initiatives funded by GOB

### **Application Process:**

#### Step 1: Eligibility

- 1. Eligible businesses and companies\* will be able to register with BTS without incurring any accrued tax penalties, or interest related to business tax obligations.
- 2. To qualify for the MSME Amnesty Programme, your business or company must meet two out of three of the criteria (employees, annual sales, total assets) of the MSME definition below:

| Indicator | Employees | Annual Sales               | Total Assets               |
|-----------|-----------|----------------------------|----------------------------|
| Micro     | < 10      | <\$200,000                 | <\$200,000                 |
| Small     | 10-49     | \$200,000- < \$6 million   | \$200,000- < \$6 million   |
| Medium    | 50-300    | \$6 million - \$30 million | \$6 million - \$30 million |

#### Step 2: Registration under MSME Amnesty Programme

- 1. Visit Small Business Development Center at BELTRAIDE for assistance with:
  - a. Registration of your company as a business name under the Business Names Act, Chapter 247, (Belize Companies & Corporate Affairs Registry (bccar.bz));
  - b. Registration with the BTS (Register User Account Belize Tax Service (bts.gov.bz))
  - c. Submission of completed Advising Request Form
  - d. Submission of completed MSME Amnesty Application Form (<a href="https://forms.gle/wndKHJbxRztPypa1A">https://forms.gle/wndKHJbxRztPypa1A</a>)
- 2. MSME application form must be accompanied by:
  - a. Copy of a valid identification (Passport or Social security card)
  - b. Copy of rental receipt/land title/written permission to occupy
  - c. Proof of submission of application for a Trade License, (if applicable)
  - d. BELTRAIDE/SBDC issued MSME client ID
- 3. Interested MSMEs must complete and submit an application form on or before <u>October</u> 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

#### Step 3: Collect your MSME Amnesty Certificate

- 1. After seven (7) days of completion of step 2, your MSME Amnesty Certificate will be issued.
- 2. Proceed to the BTS for verification of waiver and one (1) year exemption.
- \*Companies that conduct activities listed below shall not be eligible under the MSME Amnesty Programme.
  - 1. A bar that is not an ancillary to a hotel
  - 2. Gaming and Lotteries
  - 3. Retail or Wholesale of Imported Goods or Services
  - 4. Real Estate
  - 5. Professional and Consultancy Services that are not Global Digital Services
  - 6. Financial or Money Lending Services
  - 7. Import, Retail, or Wholesale of Petroleum-Based Products
  - 8. Restaurant that is not an ancillary to a hotel
  - 9. Construction and Masonry
  - 10. Rental of Real Estate or Goods not including hotels or auto rental services
  - 11. Production or Sale of any Service or Good or Prohibited by any Law
  - 12. Entertainment Promotion Services, excluding Promotion of Local Artists or Entertainers
  - 13. Auto Rental Services
